NOTICE TO HUNTERS REGARDING MONTGOMERY TOWNSHIP'S
2023-2024 MUNICIPAL DEER MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Montgomery Township will make certain municipally-owned properties available to properly licensed hunters during the 2023-2024 deer hunting season, for the sole and limited purpose of culling white-tailed deer. Only hunters who have applied for and received a 2023-2024 municipal deer management permit may participate in this program. To be eligible for a permit, the applicant must be at least 18 years old, provide proof at least \$1 million in general liability insurance, and possess a current New Jersey hunting license. Any applicant who is prohibited by law from possessing a firearm, who has been convicted of a felony or who within the past ten years has violated New Jersey's Fish and Game Code or any local rule or regulation pertaining to parks or to hunting shall not be eligible for a municipal deer management permit.

Applications and property information for municipal deer management permits and Youth Hunting permits may be requested by calling (908) 359-8211 or by downloading the form from the Township's web site, www.montgomerynj.gov

Completed applications must be received in the Township Clerk's office no earlier than 8:00 a.m. on Monday, May 15, 2023 and no later than 4:30 p.m. on June 2, 2023. Applications will be logged in by the Township Clerk and processed on a first-come, first-served basis, except that any past permittee who is applying to hunt the same property he or she has previously hunted and who meets the eligibility requirements set forth in Section 9-9e of the Montgomery Township Code will be given priority over other applicants for that particular property only.
